This too exhibits almost exclusively red berry fruit scents and in particular cherry along with hints of kirsch, floral, spice and tea. There is lovely vibrancy and freshness to the detailed, intense and sleek medium weight flavors that are shaped by firm but ripe tannins on the balanced and lingering finish that is also beautifully persistent. The Gap's Crown is a bit more structured but this is finer and should drink well a few years earlier. Worth considering. **91 Points**–Allen Meadows, January 2016
