### **2022 Fulcrum Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

Another awesome wine in the Fulcrum lineup, the 2022 'Wildcat Mountain' Pinot Noir utilizes clonal selections 777, 667 and Pommard Pinot Noir, as this was stored for 11 months in 36% new French oak prior to bottling. This displays rocky soils that mingle well with rich blackberry and red raspberry flavors alongside plenty of salty minerals. An awesome wine to savor now, enjoy over the next ten years. Drink 2024-2033 **93 Points**

### **Fulcrum 2021 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

Handsome oak spices like cinnamon, nutmeg and maple dress up this well-concentrated wine, adding complexity to its vivid black cherry, raspberry and cranberry flavors. Moderate tannins and tangy acidity give it a palate-cleansing texture. **93 Points** — Jim Gordon

### **2021 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

Friendly, with a burst of hibiscus and violet notes backed by a stream of raspberry and boysenberry coulis. The finish is dusted with singed tea and vanilla. Drink now through 2026. **90 Points** – James Molesworth

### **2021 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

The 'Wildcat Mountain' Pinot Noir utilizes clonal selections 777, 667 and Pommard Pinot Noir, as this was stored for 11 months in 36% new French oak prior to bottling. Juicy red fruits collide with citrus blossom water and stony minerals with freshly tilled rocky soils. Complex and delicious, savor this beauty over the next decade. Drink 2023-2033. **92 Points**

### **Fulcrum 2019 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

Full of rich baked red fruit that presents as dense and concentrated on the palate, this wine offers teases of citrus that keep it bright and lively, with accents of dried herb and forest floor. Medium bodied, it has balanced oak and tannin that come together harmoniously on a spicy finish.

**Fulcrum 2018 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

Immediately impressing on initial nosing for its combination of richness and refinement, this top-shelf Pinot marries plentiful, very pure, ripe cherry fruit with a careful dollop of creamy oak and sports lovely highlights of violet-like sweetness as a most appealing bonus. Fairly full on the palate but beautifully balanced and keyed on slightly succulent fruit from entry on through to its very long finish, this is a complete look at the variety that hits all the right marks and promises to evolve splendidly for a half-decade if not more. **93 Points** - June 2020

**Fulcrum 2018 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

Moving to the three Pinot Noirs, the 2018 Pinot Noir Wildcat Mountain Vineyard comes from a site in Carneros and spent 11 months in one-third new French oak. It offers a classic California Pinot nose of ripe berry fruits, spice, cola, and bay leaf. This carries to a fruit-forward, sexy Pinot Noir that has terrific purity of fruit, no hard edges, and a great finish. **Fulcrum 2018 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir, Carneros**

Pale to medium ruby, the 2018 Pinot Noir Wildcat Mountain Vineyard offers cranberries, Bing cherries and blackberries with notes of earth, amaro and dried herbs on the nose. The palate is medium-bodied with sweet berry fruit, a soft frame and long, juicy finish with a touch of warmth. **91 Points** - *Erin Brooks, August 2020*

This is aromatically quite similar to the Hogan's Run with the addition of a touch of menthol character. I again like the sleek mouthfeel of the nicely detailed flavors that possess very good verve and intensity while displaying fine length on the focused, linear and compact finish that is youthfully austere. ### **2017 Fulcrum Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Carneros Pinot Noir**

Carneros Sonoma County. At once very substantial and long on deep, well-extracted fruit but also a wonderfully well-balanced and comparatively supple Pinot that manages to be as polished as it is so very rich, Fulcrum's offering from the Wildcat Mountain Vineyard is a generous, exceptionally well-made wine with great fruit reserve. ### **Fulcrum 2017 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir (Carneros)**

Pale to medium ruby-purple, the 2017 Pinot Noir Wildcat Mountain Vineyard has a nose of cranberry sauce, blueberry and blackberry with a spicy background. Medium-bodied, it gives pure red, blue and black fruits in the mouth, with grainy structuring tannins and a sweet fruit finish. **92+ Points** - Erin Brooks, April 2019

### **2017 Fulcrum Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Carneros Pinot Noir**

Clones 667, 777 and Pommard. Aged 11 months in French oak barrels, 35% new. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered. Moderate garnet color in the glass. Aromas of blackest cherry, chocolate sundae, exotic spices and vanilla. Light to mid weight flavors of blackberry and black raspberry with a deft touch of oak. A very pleasing gulp of nicely ripened fruit backed by civilized tannins and finishing with good intent. Considerably more appealing when tasted the following day from a previously opened and re-corked bottle. **92 Points** - April 2019

### **2017 Fulcrum Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Carneros Pinot Noir**

From a site in Carneros, the 2017 Pinot Noir Wildcat Mountain Vineyard sports a slightly deeper ruby color as well as lots of smoked red and black fruits, ground herbs, black tea, and underbrush. It's nicely textured, has plenty of earthy, dark fruit, and a good finish. Completely destemmed and aged 11 months in 35% new French oak, bottled unfiltered and unfiltered, drink it over the coming 6-8 years. **92 Points** - Jeb Dunnuck, June 2019

### **Fulcrum 2016 Wildcat Mountain Vineyard Pinot Noir (Carneros)**

Pale ruby-purple colored, the 2016 Pinot Noir Wildcat Mountain Vineyard features very pretty notes of raspberries, wild strawberries and cranberries with touches of fragrant earth, lavender and bay leaves. Medium-bodied and wonderfully elegant with a beautiful, quiet intensity in the mouth, the sustained red berry and earth flavors are supported by fine-grained tannins and a lively line, finishing long and perfumed.
