This lively, fruity and deliciously nervy wine is jazzed up by tasty raspberry and red-cherry flavors on light tannins and snappy acidity. It feels medium bodied and there is plenty of ripeness to balance the tangy structure. **91 Points** – *J.G. July 2021*

2018 On Point Winemaker's Selection Pinot Noir, North Coast

A blend of grapes from Gap's Crown, Hogan's Run and Conzelman vineyards. Aged 11 months in French oak barrels, 24% new. Moderately light garnet color in the glass. Aromas of black raspberry, cherry, vanilla and mushroom earthiness rise up from the glass. Well-endowed with juicy flavors of spicy dark red cherry and blackberry with a modicum of oak in the background. Nicely balanced tannins and forthright acidity with a lip-smacking finish. 90 Points – Rusty Gaffney, May 2020

This light to medium-bodied wine shows a charming, fresh and fruity personality backed by lipsmacking acidity and tannins. 2017 On Point Winemaker's Selection Pinot Noir (North Coast)

Generous aromas, warm and ripe fruit flavors and a gentle, mouth coating texture make this wine practically irresistible. Blended from top vineyards in three counties, it is full bodied, bursting with black cherries and raspberries, handsomely sprinkled with oak spices of cinnamon, nutmeg and clove and bolstered by fine-grained tannins. 92 Points – J.G. 2016 On Point Christinna's Cuvee, North Coast Pinot Noir A blend of grapes from Gap's Crown, Wildcat Mountain and Donnelly Creek Vineyards. Moderate garnet color in the glass. Lovely marriage of dark berry fruit and oak aromas. More refinement and restraint than the On Point Sonoma Coast bottling, featuring mid weight flavors of black cherry, blackberry and black

This fascinating medium-bodied wine has a wild streak that first brings rhubarb and forest-floor aromas, then deep dark flavor nuances like mushroom, black cherry and more tangy rhubarb. 2014 On Point Christinna's Cuvee Pinot Noir

Full bodied and definitely fruity without being sweet, this wine from Fulcrum comes straight at the taste buds with opulent black cherry and tart raspberry flavors on a vivid texture. Having spent 15 months in French oak before bottling, it tastes a bit dense and muted at this point, and should be best after 2018. **90 Points Excellent; Highly recommended** - Jim Gordon, March 2017

2014 On Point Christinna's Cuvée North Coast Pinot Noir A blend of 23% Landy Vineyard, 33% Donnelly Creek Vineyard and 44% Gap's Crown Vineyard grapes. Aged 15 months in French oak, 19% new. Moderately light reddish purple hue in the glass. A delightful blended wine offering aromas of cherry, spice, herb field and cigar box leading to a mid weight core of Bing cherry and spice flavors backed by silky tannins. A very cozy and easy to like wine that finishes with a charge of black cherry and raisin notes. "My recent blind tasting of several California Pinot Noirs included two wines that delighted me. The brand was On Point, a label of Fulcrum Wines, and the wines were a 2013 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir and a 2013 Anderson Valley Pinot Noir...both wines are excellent. On Point 2013 Christinna's Cuvée from Anderson Valley is, to my taste, a more autumnal Pinot Noir. Its aromas and flavors are more subtle and less fresh-fruity than those of the Sonoma Coast wine; along with cherry notes, the aroma suggests spice and evergreen, and the flavors hint at underbrush, earth and meatiness. Also, the wine is slightly more tannic than the Sonoma Coast Pinot, providing more gravitas. Of the two, this is perhaps the more sophisticated wine. On the table, the Anderson Valley wine had the edge because its earthy tones and more subtle fruitiness harmonize beautifully with a wider range of dishes." 90 Points -Mary Ewing-Mulligan, July 2015
